Rules of Shooting

Approved by the Board December 12, 2009

1. a) All FCA rules, as amended from time to time, apply to the extent reasonable for the provincial context, and as amended below.
- b) A reference to
 - i) FCA is a reference to BCAA
 - ii) Canada or Canadian is a reference to British Columbia or British Columbian
 - iii) national is a reference to provincial unless the reference does not reasonably apply to the provincial context.

Variances to FCA Chapter 2

2. Subject to paragraph 1 b), there are no variances to FCA Chapter 2.

Variances to FCA Chapter 3

3.1 BCAA Annual Championships

- a) *BCAA Indoor Championships*: two 18 metre FITA Indoor Rounds (FCA 4.5.2.3) shot over two days.
- b) *BCAA Outdoor Championships*: one Canadian 1200 Round (FCA 4.5.1.14) shot in one day, and one 24-target FITA Field Round (FCA 4.5.3.2) shot the following day.
- c) *BCAA 3-D Championships*: Canadian National 3-D Outdoor Championships format (FCA 3.3) excluding the Grand Prix Shoot-off (FCA 3.3.11).
- d) *JOP Indoor Championships*: one 18 metre FITA Indoor Round (FCA 4.5.2.3) shot in one day.
- e) *JOP Outdoor Championships*: one Canadian 900 Round (FCA 4.5.1.13) shot in one day.

3.2 Categories

- a) BCAA Championships use the FCA Age and Gender Classes (FCA 4.2) and Equipment Divisions (FCA 4.3), as amended by section 4, except the organizers of a BCAA Championship event may add one Equipment Division, with or without Age and Gender Class limitations.
- b) JOP Championships use the JOP Age and Gender Classes and Equipment Divisions pursuant to the BCAA JOP Manual.

3.3 Judges' Attire

- a) During a Championship event, judges
 - i) will wear a red golf shirt (long or short sleeves) and black, white or grey pants, shorts or skirt,
 - ii) may wear a red vest or jacket, and
 - iii) may wear a hat.

Variances to FCA Chapter 4

- 4.1 Addendum to FCA 4.2.3 (Age Restrictions)
 - a) To compete in a **Masters 60** class, a person must be 60 or older on December 31 of the current year.
 - b) To compete in a **Masters 70** class, a person must be 70 or older on December 31 of the current year.

4.2 Addendum to FCA 4.3.2

- a) For all Masters and Senior Classes, Longbow is also included.
- b) For all Junior and Cadet Classes, Compound Limited is also included.

Variances to FCA Chapter 5

5. Subject to paragraph 1 b), there are no variances to FCA Chapter 5.

Variances to FCA Chapter 6

6. Variance to FCA 6.1.2
 - a) Medals will be awarded to only the first place in each Guest category.

Variances to FCA Chapter 7

7. Addendum to FCA 7.3
 - a) For items permitted for the Longbow division (BCAA 4.2 a)), refer to FCA 11.19.3 "Traditional Longbow," except arrow shafts need not be wooden.

Variances to FCA Chapter 8

8. Variance to FCA 8.6.0
 - a) For only the purpose of awarding medals at BCAA Championships, inner ten scoring will not apply to any category; this section does not vary FCA 8.6.5.

Variances to FCA Chapter 9

9. Subject to paragraph 1 b), there are no variances to FCA Chapter 9.

Variances to FCA Chapter 10

10. FCA Rules do not contain a Chapter 10.

11. Subject to paragraph 1 b), there are no variances to FCA Chapter 11.
